



Brief History of Carlsbad, California.

The city of Carlsbad pretty much began when John Frazier found a well in 1880. This well was no ordinary one; the well contained healthy mineral water, which had cured a past stomachache that John had. After the discovery of mineral water, small bottling companies and the 100-room Mineral Springs Hotel came into the picture. The well is located in front of Alt Carlsbad Hanse House, a three-story, half-timbered turreted home.

From the San Diego International Airport
Get on I-5 N from N Harbor Dr and India St
Head northwest on Airport Terminal Rd
Keep left to stay on Airport Terminal Rd
Take the ramp to I-5/Downtown
Merge onto N Harbor Dr
Turn left onto W Laurel St
Turn left onto India St
Take the ramp on the left onto I-5 N
Follow I-5 N to Tamarack Ave in Carlsbad.
Take the Tamarack Ave exit from I-5 N
Merge onto I-5 N
Take the Tamarack Ave exit
Drive to Carlsbad Blvd
Turn left onto Tamarack Ave
Turn right onto Carlsbad Blvd
