A brief history lesson

Mercer PA was named after a close friend of George Washington, who was named Brigadier General Hugh Mercer. It was created on March 12, 1800, and it had a population of 3,228. By 1990 it had a population of 12,003.

The town of Mercer has had three court houses. The first, which was built in 1807 for about \$7,116, burnt to the ground in 1866. Fortunately, all important documents were saved from the fire. The second court house, which was built immediately after the first burnt down, cost about \$100,000. This court house also burnt down in December 1907. Again, all records and documents were saved from the fire. The current court house was built in 1909 for \$500,000.



Mercer Government.

Mercer's Mayor (no, not the author, Mercer Mayer) is Steven Van Woert, The legislator is Ted C. Nesbit, and the sheriff is Gary Hartman. It has a great government which is set on doing the best for Mercer's people.



Who was President when Mercer was founded? What was the political environment like?

The election of 1800 was filled with many hardships. The two main parties were the Federalists and the Republicans. Both sides thought that if the other side won, it would be the end of their brand-new nation. The Federalists wanted a stronger central government, while the Republicans wanted more power for the states.
