Brief History of Rockport, Texas.

In 1870, Rockport was established as a cattle slaughtering, packing, and shipping port. The charming fishing village of Rockport has been a favorite coastal hideaway for wealthy Texans since the 1800s. It was named for the rock ledge underlying its shore and was founded just after the Civil War.

During the 1880s boat building and fishing began to develop as important industries in Rockport. Another important industry was the Pass railroad. It had gone from San Antonio and Aransas until it reached Rockport in 1888. Two service between San Antonio and Corpus Christi, its immediate. The Fifteenth Amendment (Amendment XV) to the United States Constitution prohibits the federal and state governments from denying a citizen the right to vote based on that citizen's "race, color, or previous condition of servitude."
